FLAME Scholarship Policy

1. Funding Sources

Funding comes from fundraising and contributions designated for the scholarship fund.

2. Time Frame

Scholarships will be awarded each year term. Applications will be available at the beginning of each year term. You will be notified at that time when the deadline is to turn them in. You will be notified as to how much of a scholarship your family has been awarded in your registration form.

3. Scholarship Committee

The Scholarship Committee consists of two members, of which will be Parent Administration Committee (PAC) members. PAC members and members of their household are eligible to receive scholarships.

4. Scholarship Amount

Scholarships are awarded to families and applied to the total amount of tuition owed to FLAME for the term. The scholarship amounts per family will be decided by the scholarship committee taking into account several factors: the applicant's financial need, the extent of the families' participation in FLAME activities, the number of family members in the program, and the amount of scholarship funds currently available.

5. Scholarship Recipient Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded to home schooled or virtual schooled students with financial need and who have participated in FLAME in the past.

- **FINANCIAL NEED** - Families are deemed to be in financial need if their household income is lower than the median income for Madison, based on the number of members in their household. Household members include students in college and grandparents supported by the parent or guardian. Financial need may also exist due to extraordinary expenses such as uninsured medical bills, even when the household income exceeds the median income.

- **PARTICIPATION** - The student and the parent or guardian will have participated in FLAME's program in the current or prior semesters. Student participation includes, but is not limited to: class attendance, participation in concerts, encore performances, tours, art shows, fundraising and other FLAME activities. Parent and guardian participation includes, but is not limited to: committee assignments, fundraising, or other volunteer positions. The participation requirement may be waived in

extraordinary circumstances, including overseas religious workers on a three month to one-year assignment.
